Sturminster Newton High School A Quick Guide to Financial Support for Post-16 Students

At Sturminster Sixth Form the bursary fund is used to support students remaining in post-16 education when financial issues might impact on their time in the Sixth Form.

We aim to do this in the following ways.

- Students who the government has identified as 'highly vulnerable' such as students looked after by the local authority, care leavers (those previously incare), students who receive Income Support (in their own right) and those entitled to both Employment Support Allowance and Disability Living Allowance will receive a bursary of £1,200 in six half-termly instalments.
- Students who are eligible for free school meals or who come from families with a household income of below £26,000 will be able to apply for assistance to meet educational needs such as the cost of transport to school, equipment, books and educational visits. See 'Sixth Form Bursary Fund- Policy'
- If sufficient funds are available we may also be able to provide some support to students on a **family income of £26,000 £31,000**.
- If sufficient money is available after all identified needs have been met we will also provide a termly lump sum payment to all students eligible for support under the scheme to go towards the general costs of remaining in education.

In order to make payments promptly, it is important that all students who wish to claim assistance *return an application form to the school by 30th September.*
