RE: Head Lice

It has been brought to our attention that there are currently some cases of head lice in school.

In a school environment head lice are passed easily, by head to head contact, they like any type of hair, long or short, however they do not jump. If your child has long hair it may be of benefit to keep their hair tied back whilst in school.

We recommend checking students hair once a week and if you find any 'visitors', please treat your child's head immediately.

We understand that head lice treatments can be very expensive however wet combing with conditioner is very effective with the use of narrow toothed plastic combs.

If you need help and advice, ask your local chemist or family doctor.
