Advice on additional work students could complete during study periods

- Complete any homework set
- Read through and annotate class notes
- Read and annotate the topic PowerPoints that have been emailed to you or on Sharepoint
- Use the A Level text books that you have been issued to develop your understanding of the topics – making additional notes if required
- Make a list of any issues you don't understand, ask a "buddy" to go through the topic with you – if it is still not clear ask your teacher.
- Make revision notes, such as flash cards. Refer to these cards regularly to help retain and develop knowledge
- Use the Edexcel website to access past papers – but please be aware that this is a new course with the first exams being taken this September.
- Complete practice papers – use the mark scheme to mark them yourself. If unsure ask you teacher to assess them and give you feedback.
- Studying mark schemes will give you hints and show you what the examiners are looking for.
- Study the news (BBC News, newspapers) for any articles relevant to the topics you have recently studied.
